PARKING

No parking fees are required to enter the park. Parking is at the Area B Pavilion (follow signs). The closest entrance is the Area B Gate. If entering through the main gate, there will also be signs guiding you to the Area B Pavilion.

PACKET PICKUP/CHECK-IN

Early Packet Pickup

You can pick up your race packet on Friday, April 3, from 5:00–7:00pm at the Area B Pavilion. You must use the main gate. The Area B Gate will only be open on race day. Tell the gate attendant that you are just picking up your packet, and you should not have to pay a parking fee.

Check-In/Race-Day Packet Pickup

Saturday, April 4 — Check-in starts at 6:30 a.m. at the Area B Pavilion (follow signs).

Late Signups

Day-of-race signups are available; however, we cannot guarantee a t-shirt.

CANINES

If you have your dog with you, please remember that the park requires it to be on a 6-foot leash at all times. You must also pick up after your pet and dispose of waste properly in a trash can. Extra “doggie bags” are available at check-in.

DROP BAGS

Each racer will receive two drop bags at check-in, or you may bring your own. Make sure all bags are clearly labeled. Place your nutrition, gels, or any other items that will fit in the bag for each aid station.

Please note that it will take some time to return bags from Aid Station #2 to the finish after the race. Do not place valuables in your bags if you do not plan to wait for their return. There is no road access to Aid Station #2.

Drop Bag Details:

50K: 2 bags — Aid Station #2 and the Start/Finish (location marked)
25K: 1 bag — Aid Station #2

Place your items in the appropriate bags based on the aid station, and put them in the correct bin at check-in. 50K runners will complete two loops of the lake and pass the aid stations twice, so please keep this in mind when packing your bags.

COURSE

The course is 100% marked. A visitor race map will be available at the check-in location for friends and family, who are welcome to visit you along the course. Please note that there is no access to Aid Station #2.

AID STATIONS

Distances between Aid Stations

Start–Aid Station 1: 3.7 mi
Aid Station 1–Aid Station 2: 4 mi
Aid Station 2–Aid Station 3: 5 mi
Aid Station 3–Finish: 3 mi

When you arrive at an aid station, your bags will be laid out on tables. Please do not paw through other runners' bags. If you need assistance, ask a crew member for help.

There will be water and Gatorade in coolers, as well as snacks, at each aid station. Snacks include chips, pretzels, cookies, peanuts, soda, and candy.

RACE FINISH

Pace yourselves, finish strong, and arrive safely. Awards will be presented after the top three finishers in each division have completed their run. You may need to wait a short time, but not until the end of the race. Live results will be available at the finish line for review. **Racers must be present to receive awards.** Final results will be on ultrasignup.com.
